BUILDING THE PARIS OPERA 52' & 90' - 2020 - **NEW**

Famous for its ghost, the Garnier Opera of Paris is above all the product of a titanic building site and the symbol of the birth of a new era. From 1852 to 1870, eighteen years of flamboyance made Paris the capital of modernity.



A SEASON AT THE JUILLIARD SCHOOL 6x26 ' - 2014

Step inside the most prestigious performing arts school where Miles Davis, Pina Bausch and Kevin Spacey studied.



CHANO POZO, A CUBAN IN NEW YORK 40 ' - 2002

In his infectious exuberant new musical, Jérôme Savary takes us on a voyage round the life of percussionist Chano Pozo, who rose to fame playing alongside the American jazz greats.



ROBYN ORLIN, FROM JOHANNESBURG TO THE OPERA 90 ' - 2009

South African choreographer Robyn Orlin directed and choreographed Handel's *I'Allegro, Il Penseroso ed Il Moderato* at the Opera Garnier in Paris in April 2007.



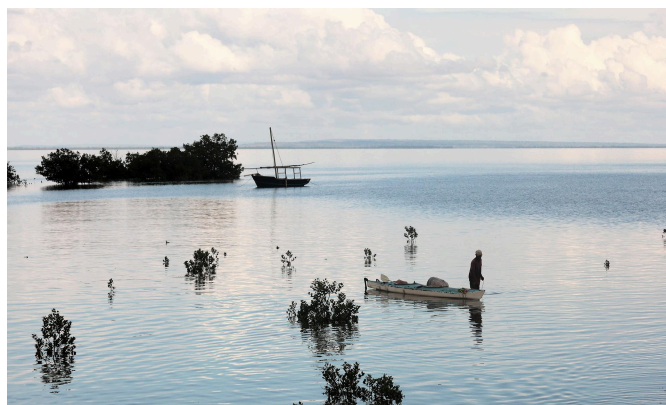
ISRAEL GALVAN: THE ANDALUSIAN ACCENT 52 ' - 2009

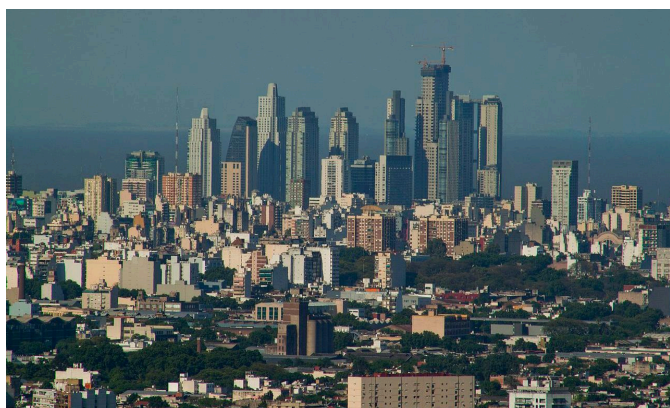
DESTINATIONS - LA TUMBA, A VERSAILLES HERITAGE IN CUBA 13' - 2020 - NEW

Santiago de Cuba is the most musical city of Cuba. This is where we sing and dance the Tumba Francesca. Literally the "French drum": ballroom dances of Versailles court, practiced with fervor by descendants of Haitian slaves. A cultural phenomenon which has survived for almost 250 years.



DESTINATIONS - THE TUFO, MOZAMBIQUE 13' - 2020 - NEW

The island of Mozambique, on the borders of East Africa, is a land of interbreeding, where Arab civilization has been able to blend with subtlety in Swahili civilization. Tufo, a traditional dance born in the land of Islam, flourished here as in no other region of Africa.



DESTINATIONS - BUENOS AIRES - TANGO 13' - 2020 - NEW

The Argentinian capital of Buenos Aires has a European flair, and for good reason, it has welcomed many immigration waves. But much more than its architecture, another heritage makes the whole city vibrate. All neighborhoods pulsate to the rhythm of Tango; everywhere we cultivate the legacy of this ...



DESTINATIONS - CAMBODIA TOLD BY ITS DANCERS 13' - 2019 - NEW

Hand movements, arched backs, feet curves... Hundreds of dancers in stone reliefs adorn the walls of the temples of Angkor, in the heart of Cambodia.



DESTINATIONS - CADIZ - ALEGRE FLAMENCO 13 ' - 2020 - **NEW**

Cadiz, its beaches, its walls, its sloping streets descending to the sea, and its flamenco. We sing it and dance it in the chapel-like bars dedicated to its worship. All the cities of Andalusia compete for the title of the birthplace of flamenco...



DESTINATIONS - DANCE, TAHITI'S SENSUAL REVOLT 13 ' - 2019

Bodies and heads decorated with garlands of flowers move to the sound of tribal percussion on the black sand of a Polynesian beach. This sacred dance, with its links to the earth, is the Ori Tahiti, which goes back to the descendants of the island's first inhabitants.



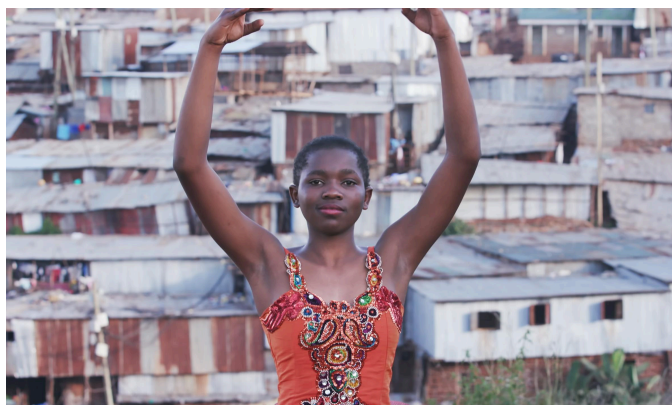
GEO REPORTS - 184 - THE TANGO BARS OF BUENOS AIRES 52 ' - 2014

Buenos Aires is loud and bewildering. But the city is also a symbol of melancholy, which is reflected in the many bars, honky-tonks and milongas where tango is danced each night. Few people have grown as rich on the music or the tango as the married couple Marcelo and Lucila.



GEO REPORTS - 315 - THE BLIND BALLERINA OF SAO PAULO 52 ' - 2020

Geyza Pereira is the world's only blind prima ballerina. She lives in São Paulo, Brazil. She learned her craft there thanks to the Cegos Ballet, a troupe for blind dancers from a unique school founded twenty-five years ago by Fernanda Bianchini.



GEO REPORTS - 299 - KENYA, DANCING INTO TOMORROW 52' - 2019

Elsy, 16, grew up in the largest slum in Nairobi, where her mother runs a small shop.



IN THE AMERICAS - 30 - PERNAMBUCO, BRAZIL'S OTHER CARNIVAL 26' - 2013

The Brazilian state of Pernambuco, about the size of Maine, is home to the megapolis of Recife, Brazil's fifth largest city and home to more than 5 million Pernambucans.



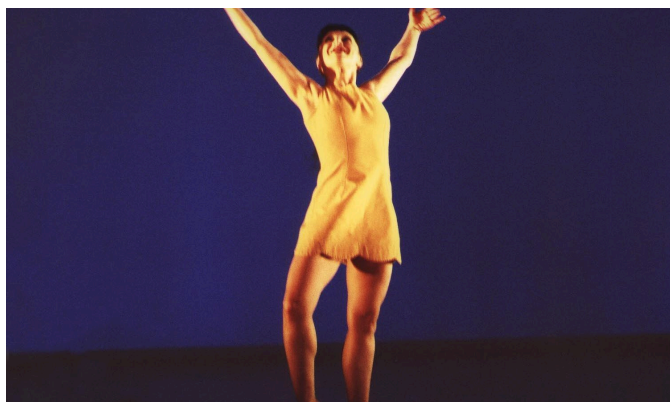
IN THE AMERICAS - 40. BRÉSIL - FAVELAS AND SAMBAS 26' - 2015

The shanty towns for which Rio de Janeiro is famous (or notorious) play a pivotal role in the city's cultural history. Favelas, as they are known, rise precipitously from near the ocean far up the hillsides.



ARTE REPORTS 2019 - EGYPT: DANCING AGAINST CENSORSHIP 24' - 2019

Belly dancing is a cornerstone of Egyptian culture - it is as popular as the pyramids. It reached its peak in the 1940s: when the Egyptian capital, a high place for free thought, was the city of arts and pleasures.



SURESNES CITES DANSE : THE FIRST TEN YEARS

This documentary presents the highlights of Suresnes Cités Danse's first decade, concentrating all the artistic influences and social trends which feed into the company's work into a single programme.



THE CHILDREN OF THE BEIJING OPERA 52 ' - 2007

A documentary about the daily life for the few hundred students studying for a career there in the art of Chinese opera.



IN SEARCH OF SECRET SPLENDOURS - 10 - TURKEY: DANCE OF THE SKIES 26 ' - 2013

At the crossroads of Europe and Asia, the city of Istanbul has changed its name and appearance several times. On account of its singular history and unique geography, it has always been a disconcerting and fascinating city.



MERCE CUNNINGHAM, THE LEGACY 52 ' - 2012

A few years after his death, this documentary looks at the extraordinary career of Merce Cunningham, the great American choreographer, and the battle for the preservation of his heritage.



FLEETING 26 ' - 2011

This choreography of Sebastien BERTAUD questions classical dance from a contemporary perspective.



LUCINDA CHILDS 52 ' - 2006

In the Seventies, France discovered a generation of new American choreographers mostly from New York. Among these artists, Lucinda Childs was one of the dominant figures.



FACES OF EUROPE - CYPRUS: STAVROS' WORLD 26 ' - 2006

Cyprus, Stavros, 40, is an oriental dancer.



CHAPLIN MUTUAL COMEDIES - COUNT (THE) 24 ' - 2013

Charlie is a tailor's handyman. He decides to borrow the identity of one of the tailor's clients, the Count Broko, to attend a function. Unfortunately, his boss (Goliath) also has the same idea, and the real count finally arrives himself, bringing the total number of counts to three.



DANCE CELEBRATION 95 ' - 2002

This programme was devised with the help of Lyon's Maison de la Danse, and consists of extracts of major works from the international contemporary dance repertoire.



MONTPELLIER DANSE 2000 100 ' - 2000

For 20 years now, the Montpellier dance festival has been the contemporary dance festival.



NIJINSKI 52 ' - 2000

This documentary - the first in French language - to be completely dedicated to Nijinski - proposes to reflect both the bright side of this clausening-star, and the obscure aspect of his madness.
