
TRAFALGAR 52




PROFESSOR OEHMINCHEN'S MAGNIFICIENT FLYING MACHINES 52'

At the turn of the 20th century, thousand of family crossed the Atlantic Ocean leaving a miserable, persecuted or uncertain existence in Europe...




A HISTORY OF THE EUROPEAN WORKING CLASS 4x52'

In the second half of the 19th century, in the United Kingdom, women began an organised campaign for the right to vote, a right that in 1905, in Edwardian England, women still lacked.




ELIOT NESS VERSUS AL CAPONE 52'

HISTORY OF RED ARMY 2x52

While everyone knows that Trotsky's name is attached to his creation, most of its past is made up of military defeats and failures, contrary to the common idea. This documentary explores its history, combining epic narrative and deconstruction of the myth.




THE HARLEM HELLFIGHTERS GREAT WAR 52' By the end of 1917 a regiment of African-American soldiers had joined the trenches in France. They discovered both the horrors of war and a world where racial segregation did not exist.



THE ADVENTURE OF THE YELLOW BIRD 52' On 13th June 1929, the yellow bird took off for the first European transatlantic flight. Half an hour after, the pilots found a stowaway on board...



NO GODS, NO MASTERS -THE STORY OF ANARCHISM 3x52' The series reveals, for the first time, the origins and destiny of a political trend that has been fighting all gods and all masters for over 150 years.



SKY HEROES 2x26' Blending sequences of traditional animation and American comic-strip, the series paints the active portraits of heroes who have made a lasting mark on the history of aviation: Charles Lindbergh and Manfred von Richthofen.



1917: THE MAKING OF A REVOLUTION 52' & 90' Through the voices of Lenin and Gorky, discover the two faces of the Russian Revolution: the theory and the practice.



YUGOSLAVIA, THE OTHER SIDE OF THE LOOKING GLASS 2x52' This documentary reveals the formation and disintegration, within our own time, of a neighbouring European State named Yugoslavia.



SCHOOL REVOLUTION 1918-1939 52' & 90' Following World War I, in a traumatised Europe, educationalists believed that a world without violence was possible. Figures like Maria Montessori or Célestin Freinet profoundly changed ideas on education.



DIED FOR FREEDOM - THE TRAGIC END OF FLIGHT "C CHARLIE" 52' This drama-documentary talls the tragic sto

This drama-documentary tells the tragic story of 7 young airmen - one Canadian and 6 British, who died in the Hautes-Pyrenees, in July 1944.





KANJI ISHIWARA, THE MAN WHO TRIGGERED THE WAR 52' & 90' From 1889 to 1949, his career took in the key moments of Japanese History, in a most spectacular and novel-like way.



MARGHERITA S, THE WOMAN WHO INVENTED MUSSOLINI 52' For Mussolini, Margherita was his shadow and his speechwriter. She was the Duce's "other wife". She was jewish.



CHALLENGING CHURCHILL 52' & 90' Winston Spencer Churchill, Nobel Prize winner, hero of World War II. Untouchable? One of the most intriguing stories of World War II as it has never been shown before.



PHILIPPE PETAIN: 1914-1945, FROM HERO TO TRAITOR 52' & 90' What weight of responsibility can prominent political figures bear, and how do they adapt or modify their decisions?



THE SS, A BARBARIC STATE 52'
Nuremberg is where Nazi congresses were held. In the city where Hitler gathered huge crowds of fanatics, the court hosted in 1945 the greatest trial in History. The Allied victors judged those responsible for the Third Reich.



ACTION T4: A DOCTOR UNDER NAZISM 52'
The film recounts the so-called "Action T4" which consisted of eliminating physical and mental disabilities and those people considered by the Nazi regime to be useless or "asocial".



GERMAN WAR 2x52'

This film, consisting entirely of archives, will recount the daily lives of both German civilians and soldiers during the six years of WW2, from its start in September 1939 up to the months following the German surrender. A plunge into the private lives of a people on the path to self-destruction.



MY LIFE IN HITLER'S GERMANY 2x52' Told only with archival documents, the film is a deeply-moving account of Germany and the Third Reich. How day by day thecountry was crushed by the dictatorship.



THE EXECUTIONERS OF KATYN 52' & 90' This film reveals for the first time, how this crime, attributed to the Nazis for 50 years, was in fact carried out by the NKVD, who secretly killed some 22,000 Polish prisoners of war in the spring of 1920.



HITLER'S EVIL SCIENCE 90

Between History and Science, this doc highlights an unknown chapter of the "Nazi Center for Scientific Research" settled in the 30s and dedicated to legitimate the political Nazi Project and the Final Solution. How could the Third Reich lead 10 years of scientific researches completely dedicated to support the Nazi ideology? How could some of the most brilliant minds of the 20th century turn away from lights and sink into darkness?



IN THE NAME OF RACE AND SCIENCE 52'
As it pieces together never-beforeseen archival footage, the film investigates a long-forgotten crime committed by a handful of Nazi scientists.



SHOAH: THE FORGOTTEN SOULS OF HISTORY 52' Soviet archives house the only filmed memories of the Holocaust. Taken on the fly, these images represent reality. But what reality?



TRACKING DOWN KLAUS BARBIE 52'
This film sheds new light on Klaus Barbie, head of the Gestapo in Lyon in 1943-44, and gives particular attention to the scandalous protections that the German and American secret services provided him with.




THE GOERING CATALOG 52' & 90' For more than a decade, the number two in the Third Reich amassed a collection of more than 5,000 art works, all meticulously detailed in a catalog. But how did Hermann Goering get his hands on these works?



The film examines the mechanisms of Nazi extortion during the Second World War, and is interspersed with current issues surrounding restitutions.



AUSCHWITZ MUSEUM 52' Here's the Auschwitz-Birkenau museum, as it appears to us: vestiges, ruins, traces. Some barbed wires, some barracks, some birches... Do they have a role or a mission today? Which one?



THE FOUR SISTERS 52', 64', 68' & 90'
Paula Biren, Ruth Elias, Ada Lichtman and Hanna
Marton - four names of Jewish women, witnesses and
survivors of the most insane and ruthless savagery.
By the director of the monumental Shoah.



THE NEIGHBOURS 102'
The director is visiting a 79-year old man whom his Jewish parents hid with a stranger's family during the German occupation of Paris. A highly emotional piece of history.






CANNES, THE FREEDOM FESTIVAL 52' Created in 1939 as a response to the rise of Fascism and Nazism, notably in the Venice Film Festival, Cannes was meant to be an event to celebrate freedom in the world and in cinema.



OF PINOCHET 52' & 85' Colonia Dignidad was founded during the 60s in Chile. This documentary tries to tear open its web. It denounces this sprawling criminal organization that no one dare defy.



KOREA: THE HUNDRED-YEAR WAR 2x52'
In 2018, for the first time since the end of the Korean War
in 1953, Donald Trump, president of the United States and
Kim Jong Un, leader of North Korea, met. Supported by
South Korean, they pledged to open a new era of peace.



A PRESIDENT FOR AMERICA: A USER'S GUIDE 52' This film looks at the profound metamorphoses the image of the President of the United States underwent since the start of the 20th century.



CASTRO'S REVOLUTION VS. THE WORLD 2x52'
For 60 years, Fidel Castro was a thorn in the side of USA and a symbol of anti-imperialist struggle.
Castro and his compatriots played a prominent role on the international stage and contributed to changing the world.



CHE GUEVARA, BEYOND THE MYTH 52' With on-camera testimonies, previously unseen documents and little known archive footage, this is the story of a man trapped by his own legend.


IRAN, DREAMS OF AN EMPIRE 52'

This documentary is a Greek tracedy fuelled

BEHIND THE RAINBOW 2x52', 120' & 138'

NELSON MANDELA, BEYOND THE MYTH 52' Mandela's legend is built in his absence, during his 27- year incarceration. On the 11th of Febrary 1990, when he is released, he doesn't know it yet, he is the most famous political prisoner of the Planet.



SIXTY EIGHT - 10 YEARS THAT SHOOK THE WORLD 4x52' & 90' What remains of the 1968 movement? Filled with Sixties fever, this series tells the powerful years of all kinds of possibilities, whose heritage still divides.






